

Relaunch Breckinridge- 9/28/2020

- **In-person Instruction will begin on an A/B schedule on September 28, 2020, for grades P-12.**
 - Monday-Thursday
 - No students will attend school on Friday under an A/B schedule
 - Students will continue to work through the school district's Remote Learning Program each day of the week. Students will receive help from their teachers on their Remote Learning assignments on the days they are assigned to attend school each week.
- **Remote Learning & Internet Access**
 - Students will need to continue working on their technology device while at home.
 - For example, a student assigned to the A group will attend in-person classes on Monday and Tuesday each week. That student will complete Remote Learning assignments on Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday each week.
 - Students with Internet access issues will be able to upload needed Remote Learning materials on their technology device at least 2 days each week while at school.
 - Feel free to reach out to your child's school if you have any questions about how this will work.
- **Students Opting to Not Attend In-Person Classes**
 - Students who choose not to attend in-person classes will need to contact their school and let them know.
 - These students will continue with the school district's Remote Learning program each day.
- **Importance of Students Staying Home when sick or waiting for a COVID-19 Test Result**
 - Students will need to stay home and complete Remote Learning for the following reasons:
 - Not feeling well
 - Waiting for a COVID-19 Test result
 - A member of the household is not feeling well and waiting for a COVID-19 Test result
 - Travels to a state on the "Advisory List"
 - 14 day Remote Learning Program after returning

 - KDPH Incidence Rate Level - Green = 0.75, Yellow = 1.0, Orange = 1.25, Red = 1.5
