Hello Cardinal Families,

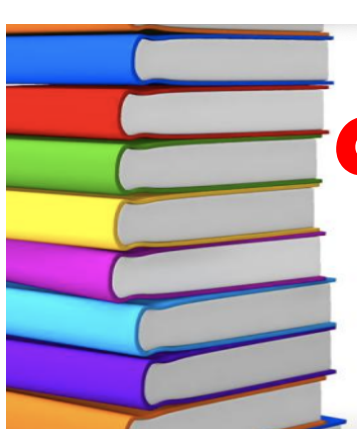

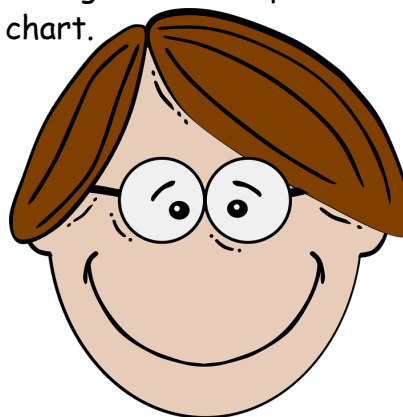

Greetings Parents! It was a busy week in the health office as we completed vision screenings, and height and weight measurements for our GLE students. The nurse vision screening does not replace the state of Kentucky new student/Kindergarten/Preschool

vision exam requirement and it is not intended to be used for diagnostic purposes. The vision screening is completed with the Welch Allyn Spot Vision Screener and is very accurate eliminating variability from children having to answer questions or read a chart.



If your student has been recommended for further evaluation by an ophthalmologist or optometrist, a letter has been sent home with a copy of your student's results. Thank you for scheduling any necessary follow up appointments timely as vision difficulty is a known education barrier to your student's success. Please let me know if you have any questions and I hope your family has a great weekend!
